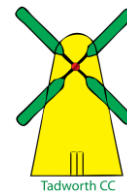

TADWORTH Cricket Club recognises the need to ensure the welfare and safety of all Young People in Cricket. As part of this commitment we will not permit photographs, video images or other images of Young People to be taken or used without the consent of the Parent/Guardian and the Young Player. TADWORTH Cricket Club follow the guidance issued in 'Safe Hands – Welfare of Young People in Cricket' on the use of images of Young People which is available at <http://www.ecb.co.uk/safehands>. TADWORTH Cricket Club will take steps to ensure that these images are used solely for the purpose they are intended, which is the promotion and celebration of cricketing activities.

If photographs e.g. team or action shots, are submitted to the Press or published on TADWORTH'S website or in our handbook individuals will not ordinarily be identified. Where a child or young person is identified it will only be with the explicit consent of parents.

Please note: TADWORTH Cricket Club understands that there are circumstances under which a parent would not wish their child to be photographed. Whilst TADWORTH Cricket Club will do all that it can to ensure the safety of children during photographed events, it is the responsibility of the parent concerned to ensure that if their child is not to be photographed and partakes in an activity and is by the nature of the activity inadvertently photographed or filmed, TADWORTH Cricket Club cannot be held responsible.

Transport to matches and practice sessions - TADWORTH Cricket Club policy is that parents or other responsible adults are responsible for transporting players to and from all matches and practice sessions and therefore the Club will not be registering Private Vehicles for the transportation of individuals in connection with any fixtures or practice sessions arranged by the Club. The implementation of this policy is not intended to exclude any player from participation and parents or guardians should contact the Club Welfare Officer if they have any problems with the transportation of players to matches or practice sessions.

Club Changing Policy - For players under the age of 16 playing in (open age) adult teams the following policy applies:

- Young players uncomfortable with changing or showering with adults are under no obligation to do so and are advised to change and shower at home
- Parental consent must be given if Young Players are to share changing facilities with adults
- If Young Players are sharing changing facilities with adults, parents have the option to supervise them whilst they are changing. The Club will make reasonable efforts to arrange this.

Juniors playing in Adult (Open Age) Cricket Policy

Further to the ECB guidelines on Junior Payers in Open Age Cricket: Under 12 age group Players and younger should not play in open age cricket. U13 age group players (12 and older) can play in open age competitive (adult) cricket. This is subject to the agreement of you the player, and your parent(s)/guardian and I agree to develop my cricket in open age competitive cricket. Subject to consultation with the Head Coach.
